STOP NOT TILL THE GOAL IS ACHIEVED

Dear Friends,

Greetings to all of you. In our Newsletter No. 25 we had shared with you the complete status of the Housing perks case filed in Hon'ble Supreme Court of India against the judgement of Hon'ble Mumbai High court.

The case came up for hearing on 18th March, 2011 in front of division bench headed by Hon'ble Chief Justice of India after we had filed an urgent application for hearing on the notice. The Hon'ble Chief Justice's bench heard the application on 18th March, 2011 and passed an interim order which has been uploaded on www.astodelhi.com. ASTO was represented by Sr. advocate Solly J. Sorabjee. The Hon'ble Supreme Court though did not stay the TDS deduction on the same has directed that the hearing of the SLP shall be expedited and if the assessee(s) ultimately succeeds the Hon'ble court shall ask the department to refund the amount so deducted. The case is listed for hearing on 11th April, 2011.

Friends, we are incurring lot of expenditure in the court case and it is difficult to proceed further in absence of sufficient funds.
