The following election schedule was finalised:




The office of the Returning Officer accepted the candidature of Mr. Amit Kumar and Mr. Sanjay Goel and the same was announced to the House.

The action to be taken in case of a tie was discussed with newly constituted ASTO-CEC and several suggestions from the members were received. The office of the Returning Officer decided to split the term of Two years of President, CWC Office equally between the two candidates in case of a Tie and the President for the first year would be decided on the basis of Toss. The Presidents would have separate General Secretary & Treasurer and the CWC would remain same for full term which shall be appointed jointly by the both Presidents. The above decision was accepted by the majority of the House and a resolution to that effect was passed by the ASTO-CEC.


Polling by secret ballot began at 7.40 pm and all the 66 CEC members exercised their franchise. Mr. B Taufik, Secretary Ankleshwar and Mr. Gaurab Das, President, Sibsagar were appointed as counting agents by Mr. Amit Kumar and Mr. Sanjay Goel respectively.

Counting began at 8:40 pm in front of the full house. The result is as follows:
